

# ECONOMIC SECTORS AUTHORIZED BUILDING PERMITS

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In December 2018<sup>1</sup>, the area authorized for building increased **0.9%** year on year.

#### **Annual variation**

In 2018, a cumulative increase of 5.1% was observed in the total area authorized for building. The increase can be attributed to the rise of 11.1% in the area designated for housing construction. In contrast, a decrease of 6.8% was observed in nonhousing construction.

#### Development in the period

In December 2018, the area authorized for building stood at 1,529,010 m<sup>2</sup>, increasing 0.9% year on year. This result was due to the rise of 8.7% in the area designated for nonhousing construction and to the fall of 3.1% in housing construction.

In nonhousing construction, the destination industry, commerce, and financial establishments (ICEF) increased 8.1% year on year, and the area designated for services rose 10.0% year on year.

In housing construction, new works decreased 5.5% year on year, and extensions increased 31.0% in the same period.

#### Permits for large-scale projects<sup>2</sup>

Permits for large-scale projects totaled 898,907 m², a decrease of 5.5% year on year. These permits were mainly associated with construction projects for buildings of one block or more and for semi-detached and detached housing. In addition, the permits were for projects of the sectors of mining, transport and storage, commerce, tourism (hospitality, hotels, cottages, and others), education (primary and tertiary), and recreational activities. The permits were also for parking lots, warehouses, and offices.

The building area of new works designated for housing totaled 634,680  $\text{m}^2$ , which represents a year-on-year decrease of 8.9%. The building area designated for economic activities (264,227  $\text{m}^2$ ) increased 3.7% as a result of the rise of 17.2% in ICEF. The authorized area of ICEF totaled 216,680  $\text{m}^2$ . In contrast, the building area designated for services fell 31.9% to stand at 47,547  $\text{m}^2$ .


