

BIRTHS

In August 2025, there were 11,807 births.

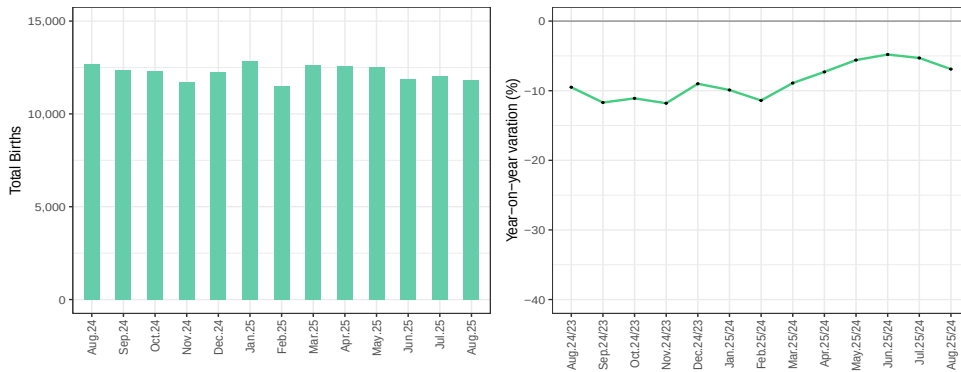
Of live births, 6,052 were males, which was 51.3% of the total, and 5,754 were females, which was 48.7%. In addition, one birth of indeterminate sex (0% of the total) was observed.

The number of births decreased 869 year on year, which represents a fall of 6.9%. The number of live births decreased 257 compared to the previous month, a monthly fall of 2.1%.

In August, the distribution of births according to the mother's age bracket was as follows: 23 live births to mothers under age 15, which was 0.2% of births, and 439 births in the bracket 15 to 19 years, which represents 3.7% of births. The bracket with the greatest number of births was to mothers aged 30 to 34 years, in which there were 3,498 live births (29.6% of the total).

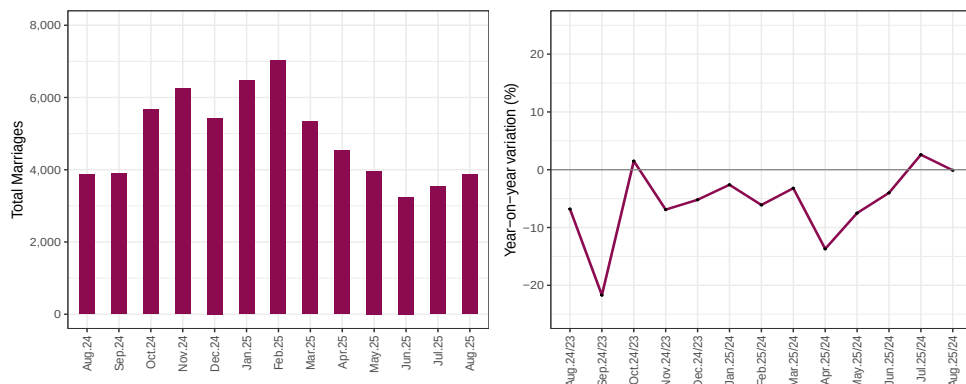
MARRIAGES AND CIVIL UNION AGREEMENTS (CUAs)

In August, there were 3,869 marriages and 1,674 Civil Union Agreements.

The number of marriages decreased by 4 cases year on year, which is equivalent to a monthly fall of 0.1%. There were 339 more marriages than in the previous month, a monthly variation of 9.6%.

■ Marriages according to month and their year-on-year variation (%).

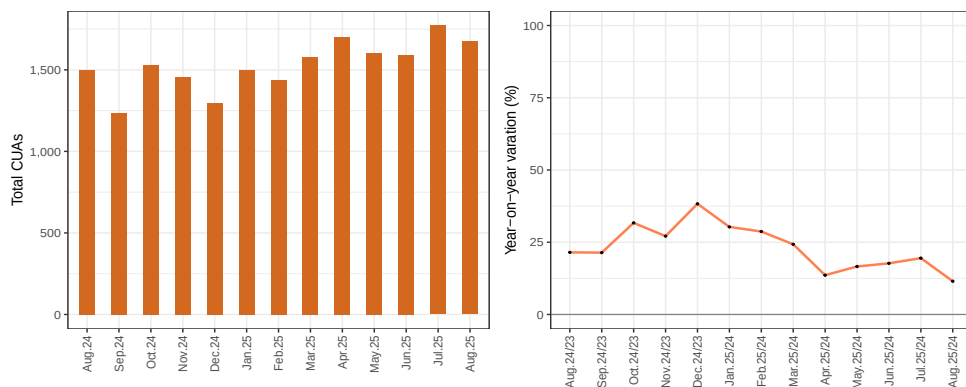
Current figures^P, August 2025



The number of civil unions rose 172 year on year, which represents an increase of 11.5%. There were 98 fewer civil unions compared to the previous month, a monthly fall of 5.5%.

Of the 1,674 CUAs in August, 1,499 (89.5%) of the couples were of different sexes. The number of CUAs between men was 82 (4.9% of the total), and the number of CUAs between women was 93 (5.6% of the total).

DEATHS

In August 2025, there were 10,989 deaths.

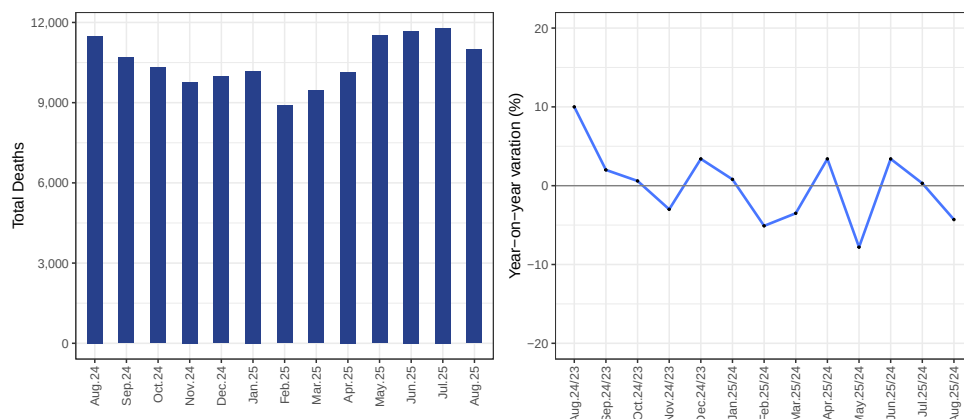
Of the total number of deaths, 5,713 were of men, which represents 52% of the total, and 5,276 were of women, which represents 48%.

The number of deaths decreased by 494 cases year on year, a fall of 4.3%. The number of deaths decreased by 801 cases compared to the previous month, which is equivalent to a monthly fall of 6.8%.

In the August distribution of deaths by age bracket, there were 60 deaths of those aged under 1 year (0.5% of the total), in most cases male. The greatest number of deaths occurred in those aged 60 and over, and the single bracket with the highest number of deaths was 80 to 99 years, in which there were 4,858 cases, or 44.2% of the total. From ages 0 to 79, there were more male deaths than female deaths, while the trend was reversed for those aged 80 and over, in which the majority of deaths were of females.
