

BIRTHS

In December 2025, there were 12,352 births.


Of live births, 6,334 were males, which is 51.3% of the total, and 6,017 were females, which is 48.7%. In addition, one birth of indeterminate sex (0% of the total) was observed.

The number of births increased 119 year on year, which represents a rise of 1%. The number of live births increased 739 compared to the previous month, a rise of 6.4%.

In December, the distribution of births according to the mother's age bracket was as follows: 15 live births to mothers under age 15, which was 0.1% of births, and 414 births in the bracket 15 to 19 years, which represents 3.4% of births. The bracket with the greatest number of births was to mothers aged 30 to 34 years, in which there were 3,683 live births (29.8% of the total).


MARRIAGES AND CIVIL UNION AGREEMENTS (CUAs)

In December, there were 5,741 marriages and 1,742 Civil Union Agreements.

The number of marriages increased by 308 year on year, which is equivalent to a rise of 5.7%. There were 572 fewer marriages than in the previous month, which represents a decrease of -9.1%.

■ Marriages according to month and their year-on-year variation (%).


Current figures^P, December 2025



The number of CUAs rose 443 year on year, which represents an increase of 34.1%. There were 69 more CUAs compared to the previous month, a monthly rise of 4.1%.

Of the 1,742 CUAs in December, 1,581 (90.8%) of the couples were of different sexes. The number of CUAs between men was 78 (4.5% of the total), while the number of CUAs between women was 83 (4.8% of the total).

DEATHS

In December 2025, there were 10,001 deaths.


Of the total number of deaths, 5,166 were of men, which represents 51.7% of the total, and 4,834 were of women, which represents 48.3%. In addition, one death of indeterminate sex (0% of the total) was observed.

The number of deaths increased by 16 cases year on year, a rise of 0.2%. The number of deaths decreased by 49 cases compared to the previous month, which is equivalent to a monthly fall of 0.5%.

In the December distribution of deaths by age bracket, there were 76 deaths of those aged under 1 year (0.8% of the total), the majority of which were male deaths. The greatest number of deaths occurred in those aged 60 and over, and the single bracket with the highest number of deaths was 80 to 99 years, in which there were 4,249 cases, or 42.5% of the total. For those aged under 1 year and those aged 5 to 79, there were more male deaths than female deaths, while the trend was reversed for those aged 80 and over and the bracket 1 to 4 years, in which the majority of deaths were of females.
