

## BIRTHS

In February 2025, there were 11,503 births.

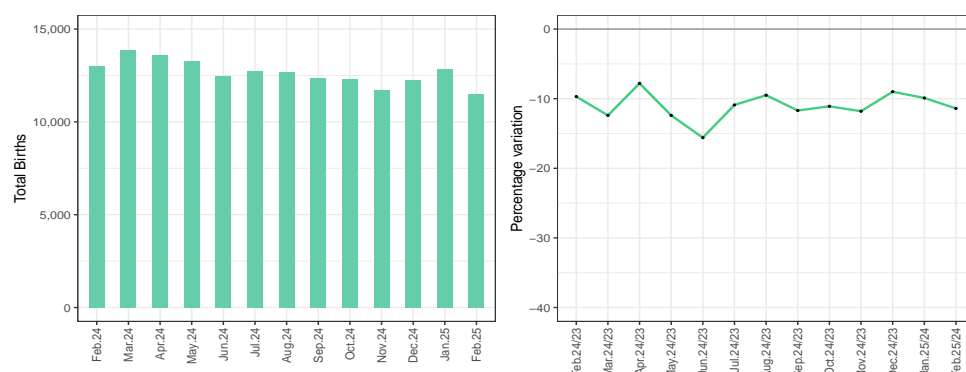
Of live births, 5,900 were males, which was 51.3% of all births, and 5,602 were females, which was 48.7%. In addition, a birth of indeterminate sex (0% of the total) was observed.

The number of births decreased 1,482 year on year, which represents a fall of 11.4%. The number of births decreased 1,324 compared to the previous month, which represents a monthly fall of 10.3%.

In February, the distribution of births according to the mother's age bracket was as follows: 7 live births of mothers under age 15, which was 0.1% of births, and 417 births in the bracket 15 to 19 years, which represents 3.6% of births. The bracket with the greatest number of births was ages 30 to 34 years, in which there were 3,399 live births (29.5% of the total).

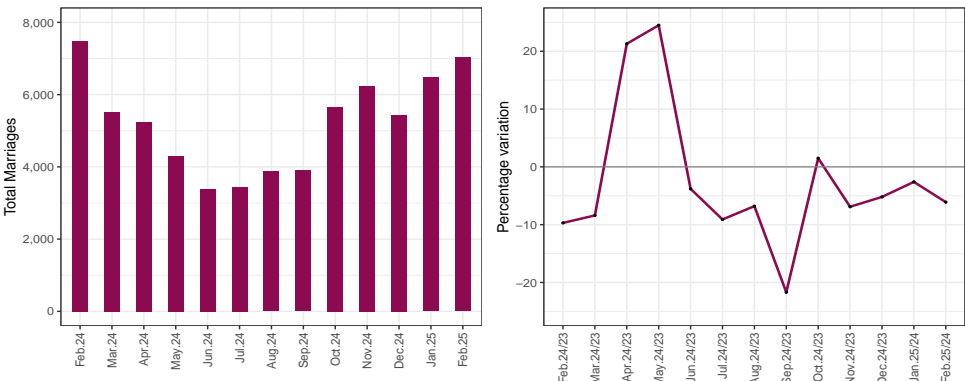

In February, there were 7,025 marriages and 1,435 Civil Union Agreements.

The number of marriages decreased 457 year on year, which is equivalent a fall of 6.1%. There were 551 more marriages than in the previous month, an increase of 8.5%.

### Marriages according to month and year-on-year variation (%).

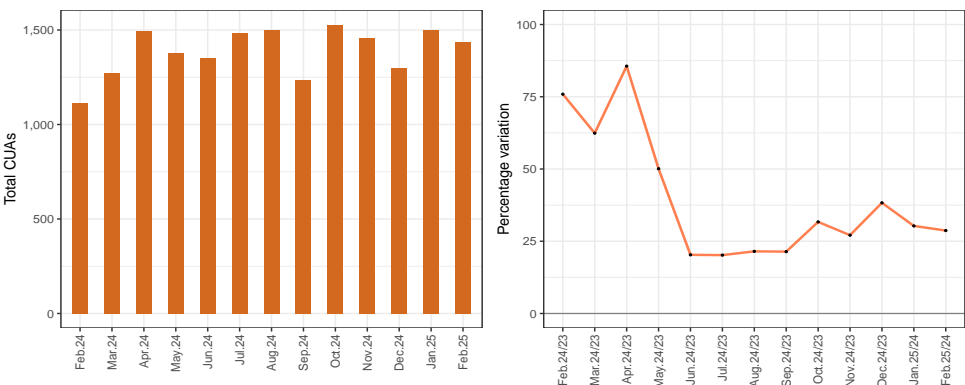

The number of civil unions rose 320 year on year, which represents an increase of 28.7%. There were 63 fewer civil unions compared to the previous month, which represents a monthly decrease of 4.2%.

Of the 1,435 CUAs in February, 1,278 (89.1%) of the couples were of different sexes. The number of CUAs between men was 66 (4.6% of the total), and the number of CUAs between women was 91 (6.3% of the total).

# DEATHS

In February 2025, there were 8,894 deaths.

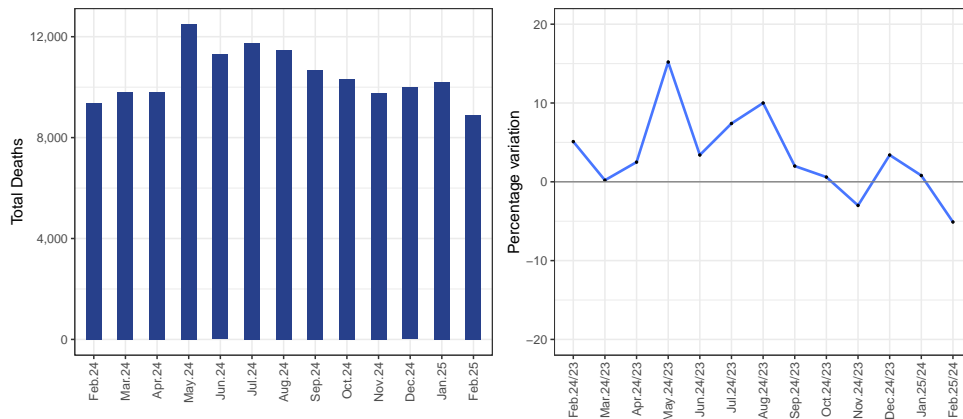
Of the total number of deaths, 4,608 were of men, which represents 51.8% of the total, and 4,286 were of women, which represents 48.2%.

The number of deaths decreased by 479 cases year on year, a fall of 5.1%. The number of deaths declined 1,300 from the previous month, which is equivalent to a fall of 12.8%.

In the February distribution of deaths by age bracket, there were 81 deaths of those aged under 1 year (0.9% of the total), in most cases male. The greatest number of deaths occurred in those aged 60 and over, and the single bracket with the highest number of deaths was 80 to 99 years, in which there were 3,657 cases, or 41.1% of the total. From ages 1 to 79, there were more male deaths than female deaths, while the trend was reversed for those aged 80 and over, in which the majority of deaths were of females.
