## **BIRTHS**


In January 2025, there were 12,827 births. Of live births, 6,538 were males, which was 51% of all births, and 6,288 were females, which was 49%. In addition, a birth of indeterminate sex (0% of the total) was observed.

The number of births decreased 1,397 year on year, a fall of 9.8% from the total number of births in January 2024, which stood at 14,224. (The preliminary figure for January 2024, published in March 2024, was 12,727 births.)

In January, the distribution of births according to the mother's age bracket was as follows: 7 live births of mothers under age 15, which was 0.1% of births, and 468 births in the bracket 15 to 19 years, which represented 3.6% of births. The bracket with the greatest number of births was ages 30 to 34 years, in which there were 3,799 live births (29.6% of the total.)


# MARRIAGES AND CIVIL UNION AGREEMENTS (CUA)

In January, there were 6,474 marriages and 1,498 Civil Union Agreements.

The number of marriages decreased 172 year on year, which is equivalent a fall of 2.6% compared to the same month in 2024, when there were 6,646 marriages (six more than there were in the preliminary figure published in March 2024).

## ■ Regional distribution of marriages.



The number of civil unions rose 348 year on year, which represents an increase of 30.3% from de total number of CUAs in January 2024, which stood at 1,150 (ten more than there were in the preliminary figure published in March 2024.)

Of the 1,498 CUAs in January, 1,313 (87.7%) of the couples were of different sexes. The number of CUAs between men was 71 (4.7% of the total), and the number of CUAs between women was 114 (7.6% of the total).

## **DEATHS**

In January 2025, there were 10,194 deaths.


Of the total number of deaths, 5,211 were of men, which represents 51.1% of the total, and 4,983 were of women, which represents 48.9%.

The number of deaths increased by 89 cases year on year, a rise of 0.9% compared to January 2024, when there were 10,105 deaths. (The preliminary figure published in March 2024 was 9,680 deaths.)

In the January distribution of deaths by age bracket, there were 74 deaths of those aged under 1 year (0.7% of the total), in most cases male. The greatest number of deaths occurred in those aged 60 and over, and the single bracket with the highest number of deaths was 80 to 99 years, in which there were 4,150 cases, or 40.7% of the total. From ages 1 to 79, there were more male deaths than female deaths, while the trend was reversed for those aged 80 and over, in which the majority of deaths were of females.
