

BIRTHS

In July 2025, there were 12,064 births.

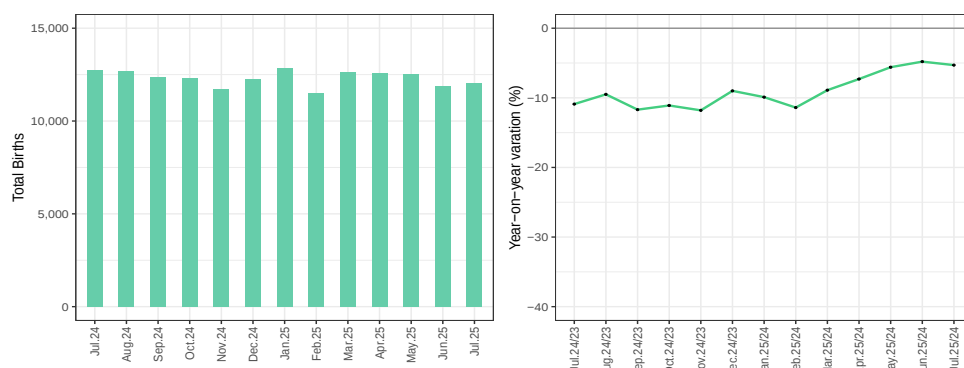
Of live births, 6,155 were males, which was 51% of the total, and 5,908 were females, which was 49%. In addition, one birth of indeterminate sex (0% of the total) was observed.

The number of births decreased 677 year on year, which represents a fall of 5.3%. The number of live births decreased 211 compared to the previous month, a monthly fall of 1.8%.

In July, the distribution of births according to the mother's age bracket was as follows: 8 live births to mothers under age 15, which was 0.1% of births, and 415 births in the bracket 15 to 19 years, which represents 3.4% of births. The bracket with the greatest number of births was to mothers aged 30 to 34 years, in which there were 3,605 live births (29.9% of the total).

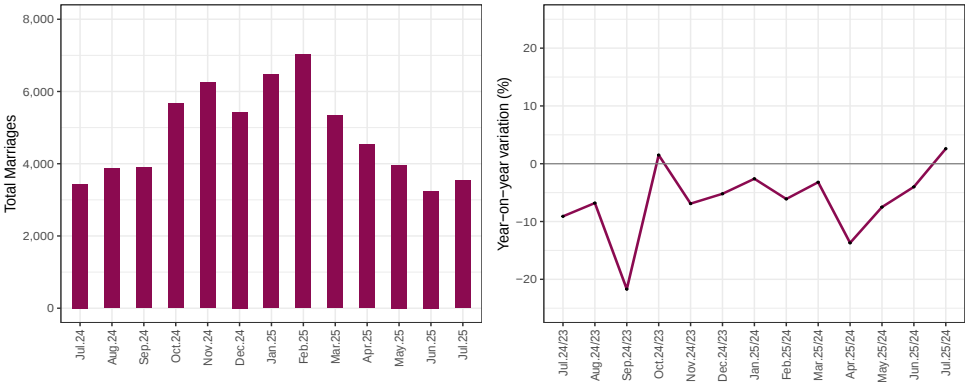
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MARRIAGES AND CIVIL UNION AGREEMENTS (CUAs)

In July, there were 3,530 marriages and 1,772 Civil Union Agreements.

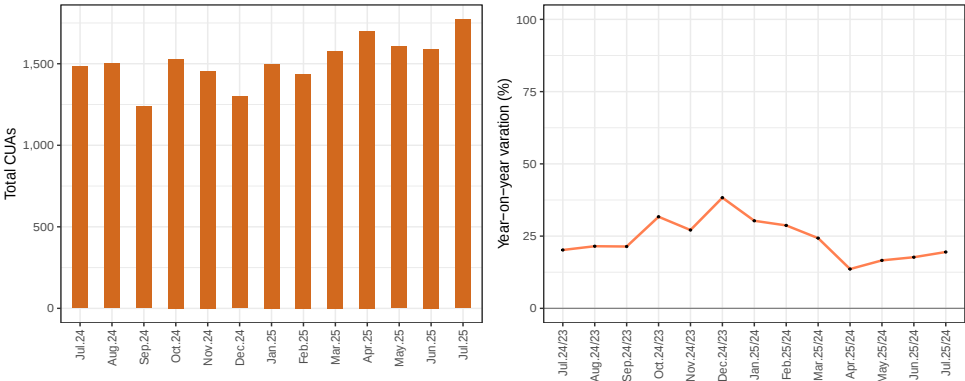
The number of marriages increased 91 year on year, which is equivalent to a monthly rise of 2.6%. There were 282 more marriages than in the previous month, a monthly variation of 8.7%.

The number of civil unions rose 289 year on year, which represents an increase of 19.5%. There were 181 fewer civil unions compared to the previous month, a monthly fall of 11.4%.

Of the 1,772 CUAs in July, 1,585 (89.4%) of the couples were of different sexes. The number of CUAs between men was 89 (5% of the total), and the number of CUAs between women was 98 (5.5% of the total).

DEATHS

In July 2025, there were 11,790 deaths.

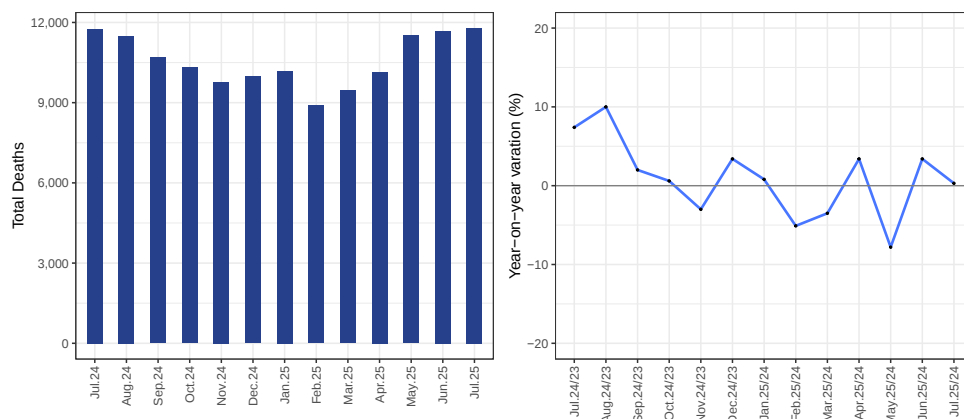
Of the total number of deaths, 6,194 were of men, which represents 52.5% of the total, and 5,596 were of women, which represents 47.5%.

The number of deaths increased by 30 cases year on year, a rise of 0.3%. The number of deaths increased by 117 cases compared to the previous month, which is equivalent to a monthly rise of 1%.

In the July distribution of deaths by age bracket, there were 57 deaths of those aged under 1 year (0.5% of the total), in most cases female. The greatest number of deaths occurred in those aged 60 and over, and the single bracket with the highest number of deaths was 80 to 99 years, in which there were 5,291 cases, or 44.9% of the total. From ages 1 to 79, there were more male deaths than female deaths, while the trend was reversed for those aged 80 and over, in which the majority of deaths were of females.
