BIRTHS


In June 2025, there were 11,853 births.

Of live births, 6,055 were males, which was 51.1% of the total, and 5,798 were females, which was 48.9%.

The number of births decreased 599 year on year, which represents a fall of 4.8%. The number of live births decreased 690 compared to the previous month, which represents a monthly fall of 5.5%.

In June, the distribution of births according to the mother's age bracket was as follows: 11 live births of mothers under age 15, which was 0.1% of births, and 429 births in the bracket 15 to 19 years, which represents 3.6% of births. The bracket with the greatest number of births was ages 30 to 34 years, in which there were 3,438 live births (29% of the total).



MARRIAGES AND CIVIL UNION AGREEMENTS (CUAs)

In June, there were 3,248 marriages and 1,591 Civil Union Agreements.


The number of marriages decreased 137 year on year, which is equivalent to a fall of 4%. There were 722 fewer marriages than in the previous month, which represents a monthly variation of -18.2%.

The number of civil unions rose 239 year on year, which represents an increase of 17.7%. There were 14 fewer civil unions compared to the previous month, which represents a monthly fall of 0.9%.

Of the 1,591 CUAs in June, 1,409 (88.6%) of the couples were of different sexes. The number of CUAs between men was 75 (4.7% of the total), and the number of CUAs between women was 107 (6.7% of the total).

DEATHS


In June 2025, there were 11,673 deaths.

Of the total number of deaths, 6,085 were of men, which represents 52.1% of the total, and 5,588 were of women, which represents 47.9%.

The number of deaths increased by 381 cases year on year, a rise of 3.4%. The number of deaths increased by 154 cases from the previous month, which is equivalent to a monthly rise of 1.3%.

In the June distribution of deaths by age bracket, there were 64 deaths of those aged under 1 year (0.5% of the total), in most cases male. The greatest number of deaths occurred in those aged 60 and over, and the single bracket with the highest number of deaths was 80 to 99 years, in which there were 5,114 cases, or 43.8% of the total. From ages 0 to 79, there were more male deaths than female deaths, while the trend was reversed for those aged 80 and over, in which the majority of deaths were of females.
