

## BIRTHS

In March 2025, there were 12,654 births.

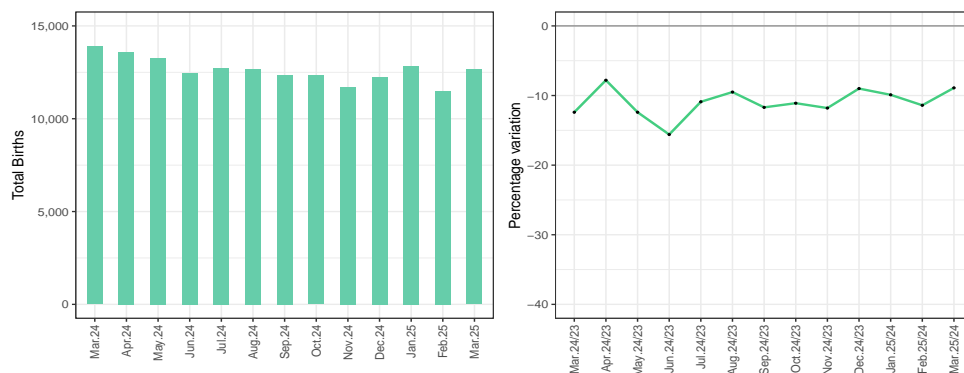
Of live births, 6,409 were males, which was 50.6% of the total, and 6,243 were females, which was 49.3%. In addition, two births of indeterminate sex (0% of the total) were observed.

The number of births decreased 1,234 year on year, which represents a fall of 8.9%. The number of live births increased 1,151 compared to the previous month, which represents a monthly rise of 10%.

In March, the distribution of births according to the mother's age bracket was as follows: 19 live births of mothers under age 15, which was 0.2% of births, and 416 births in the bracket 15 to 19 years, which represents 3.3% of births. The bracket with the greatest number of births was ages 30 to 34 years, in which there were 3,805 live births (30.1% of the total).

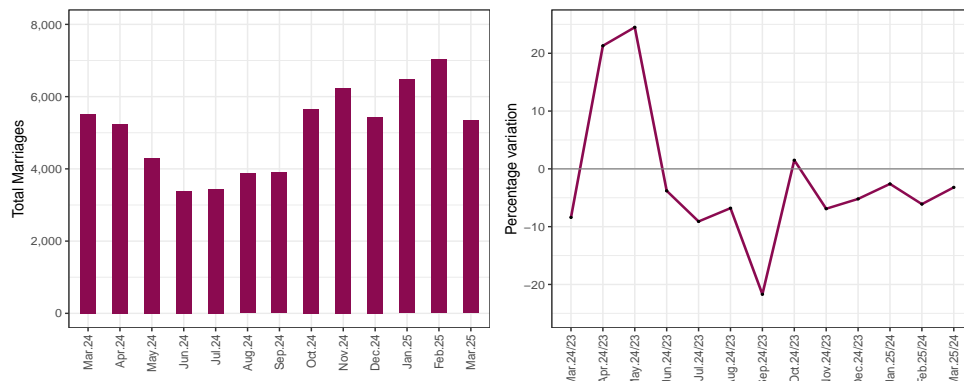
# MARRIAGES AND CIVIL UNION AGREEMENTS (CUA)

In March, there were 5,340 marriages and 1,578 Civil Union Agreements.

The number of marriages decreased 175 year on year, which is equivalent a fall of 3.2%. There were 1,685 fewer marriages than in the previous month, a fall of 24%.

## ■ Marriages according to month and year-on-year variation (%).

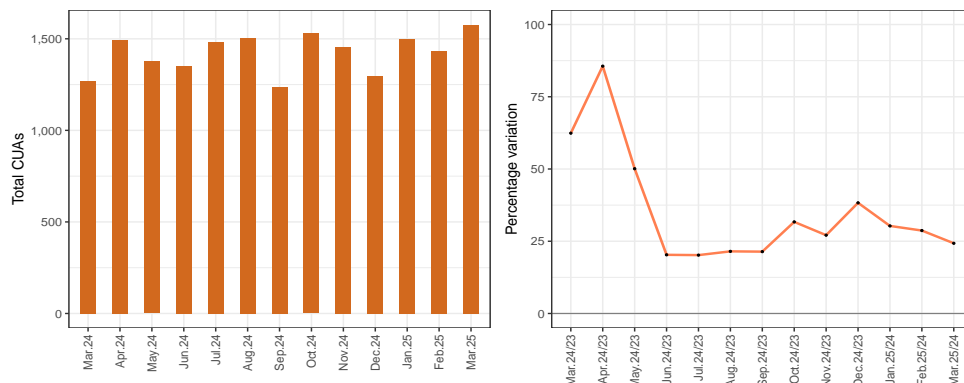

The number of civil unions rose 308 year on year, which represents an increase of 24.3%. There were 143 more civil unions compared to the previous month, which represents a monthly increase of 10%.

Of the 1,578 CUAs in March, 1,391 (88.1%) of the couples were of different sexes. The number of CUAs between men was 90 (5.7% of the total), and the number of CUAs between women was 97 (6.1% of the total).

# DEATHS

In March 2025, there were 9,459 deaths.

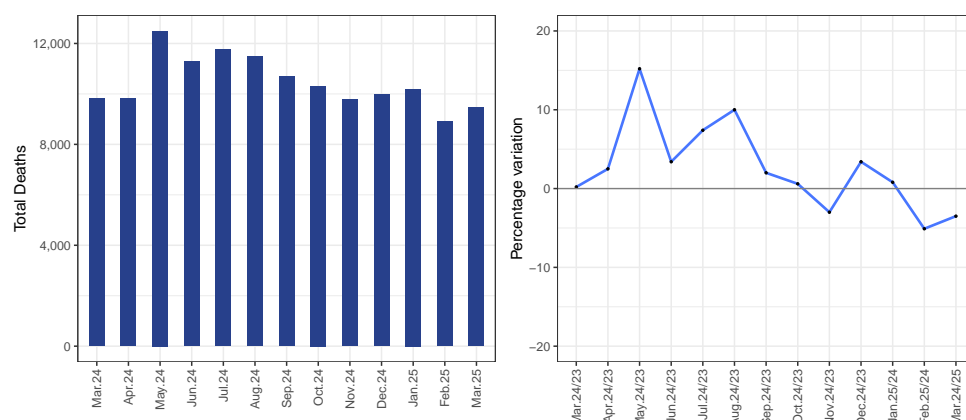
Of the total number of deaths, 4,997 were of men, which represents 52.8% of the total, and 4,461 were of women, which represents 47.2%. In addition, one death of indeterminate sex (0% of the total) was observed.

The number of deaths decreased by 347 cases year on year, a fall of 3.5%. The number of deaths increased by 565 cases from the previous month, which is equivalent to a rise of 6.4%.

In the March distribution of deaths by age bracket, there were 84 deaths of those aged under 1 year (0.9% of the total), in most cases male. The greatest number of deaths occurred in those aged 60 and over, and the single bracket with the highest number of deaths was 80 to 99 years, in which there were 3,867 cases, or 40.9% of the total. From ages 5 to 79, there were more male deaths than female deaths, while the trend was reversed for those aged 80 and over, in which the majority of deaths were of females.
