BIRTHS


In May 2025, there were 12,543 births.

Of live births, 6,342 were males, which was 50.6% of the total, and 6,200 were females, which was 49.4%. In addition, one birth of indeterminate sex (0% of the total) was observed.

The number of births decreased 741 year on year, which represents a fall of 5.6%. The number of live births decreased 43 compared to the previous month, which represents a monthly fall of 0.3%.

In May, the distribution of births according to the mother's age bracket was as follows: 9 live births of mothers under age 15, which was 0.1% of births, and 404 births in the bracket 15 to 19 years, which represents 3.2% of births. The bracket with the greatest number of births was ages 30 to 34 years, in which there were 3,737 live births (29.8% of the total).



MARRIAGES AND CIVIL UNION AGREEMENTS (CUAs)

In May, there were 3,970 marriages and 1,605 Civil Union Agreements.


The number of marriages decreased 323 year on year, which is equivalent a fall of 7.5%. There were 557 fewer marriages than in the previous month, a fall of 12.3%.

The number of civil unions rose 229 year on year, which represents an increase of 16.6%. There were 94 fewer civil unions compared to the previous month, which represents a monthly fall of 5.5%.

Of the 1,605 CUAs in May, 1,447 (90.2%) of the couples were of different sexes. The number of CUAs between men was 84 (5.2% of the total), and the number of CUAs between women was 74 (4.6% of the total).

DEATHS


In May 2025, there were 11,519 deaths.

Of the total number of deaths, 6,015 were of men, which represents 52.2% of the total, and 5,503 were of women, which represents 47.8%. In addition, one death of indeterminate sex (0% of the total) was observed.

The number of deaths decreased by 977 cases year on year, a fall of 7.8%. The number of deaths increased by 1,364 cases from the previous month, which is equivalent to a rise of 13.4%.

In the May distribution of deaths by age bracket, there were 71 deaths of those aged under 1 year (0.6% of the total), in most cases female. The greatest number of deaths occurred in those aged 60 and over, and the single bracket with the highest number of deaths was 80 to 99 years, in which there were 4,947 cases, or 42.9% of the total. From ages 1 to 79, there were more male deaths than female deaths, while the trend was reversed for those aged 80 and over, in which the majority of deaths were of females.
