

BIRTHS

In November 2025, there were 11,613 births.


Of live births, 5,889 were males, which is 50.7% of the total, and 5,724 were females, which is 49.3%.

The number of births decreased 82 year on year, which represents a fall of 0.7%. The number of live births decreased 458 compared to the previous month, a fall of 3.8%.

In November, the distribution of births according to the mother's age bracket was as follows: 13 live births to mothers under age 15, which was 0.1% of births, and 333 births in the bracket 15 to 19 years, which represents 2.9% of births. The bracket with the greatest number of births was to mothers aged 30 to 34 years, in which there were 3,393 live births (29.2% of the total).


MARRIAGES AND CIVIL UNION AGREEMENTS (CUAs)

In November, there were 6,313 marriages and 1,673 Civil Union Agreements.

The number of marriages increased by 71 year on year, which is equivalent to a rise of 1.1%. There were 324 more marriages than in the previous month, which represents an increase of 5.4%.

Marriages according to month and their year-on-year variation (%).


Current figures^P, November 2025



The number of CUAs rose 217 year on year, which represents an increase of 14.9%. There were 161 fewer CUAs compared to the previous month, a monthly fall of 8.8%.

Of the 1,673 CUAs in November, 1,498 (89.5%) of the couples were of different sexes. The number of CUAs between men was 72 (4.3% of the total), while the number of CUAs between women was 103 (6.2% of the total).

DEATHS

In November 2025, there were 10,050 deaths.


Of the total number of deaths, 5,200 were of men, which represents 51.7% of the total, and 4,850 were of women, which represents 48.3%.

The number of deaths increased by 280 cases year on year, a rise of 2.9%. The number of deaths decreased by 675 cases compared to the previous month, which is equivalent to a monthly fall of 6.3%.

In the November distribution of deaths by age bracket, there were 72 deaths of those aged under 1 year (0.7% of the total), in most cases male. The greatest number of deaths occurred in those aged 60 and over, and the single bracket with the highest number of deaths was 80 to 99 years, in which there were 4,350 cases, or 43.3% of the total. For those aged under 1 year and those aged 5 to 79, there were more male deaths than female deaths, while the trend was reversed for those aged 80 and over, in which the majority of deaths were of females. For the bracket 1 to 4 years, the numbers of male and females deaths were identical.
