

BIRTHS

In October 2025, there were 12,071 births.


Of live births, 6,229 were males, which was 51.6% of the total, and 5,842 were females, which was 48.4%.

The number of births decreased 253 year on year, which represents a fall of 2.1%. The number of live births decreased 228 compared to the previous month, a monthly fall of 1.9%.

In October, the distribution of births according to the mother's age bracket was as follows: 14 live births to mothers under age 15, which was 0.1% of births, and 430 births in the bracket 15 to 19 years, which represents 3.6% of births. The bracket with the greatest number of births was to mothers aged 30 to 34 years, in which there were 3,539 live births (29.3% of the total).


MARRIAGES AND CIVIL UNION AGREEMENTS (CUAs)

In October, there were 5,989 marriages and 1,834 Civil Union Agreements.

The number of marriages increased by 326 year on year, which is equivalent to a monthly rise of 5.8%. There were 1,737 more marriages than in the previous month, a monthly variation of 40.9%.

■ Marriages according to month and their year-on-year variation (%).


Current figures^P, October 2025



The number of civil unions rose 305 year on year, which represents an increase of 19.9%. There were 235 more civil unions compared to the previous month, a monthly rise of 14.7%.

Of the 1,834 CUAs in October, 1,664 (90.7%) of the couples were of different sexes. The number of CUAs between men was 63 (3.4% of the total), and the number of CUAs between women was 107 (5.8% of the total).

DEATHS

In October 2025, there were 10,725 deaths.


Of the total number of deaths, 5,526 were of men, which represents 51.5% of the total, and 5,199 were of women, which represents 48.5%.

The number of deaths increased by 417 cases year on year, a rise of 4%. The number of deaths increased by 14 cases compared to the previous month, which is equivalent to a monthly rise of 0.1%.

In the October distribution of deaths by age bracket, there were 74 deaths of those aged under 1 year (0.7% of the total), in most cases male. The greatest number of deaths occurred in those aged 60 and over, and the single bracket with the highest number of deaths was 80 to 99 years, in which there were 4,708 cases, or 43.9% of the total. For those aged under 1 year and those aged 5 to 79, there were more male deaths than female deaths, while the trend was reversed for those aged 80 and over and the bracket 1 to 4 years, in which the majority of deaths were of females.
