

BIRTHS

In April 2026, there were 12,542 births.

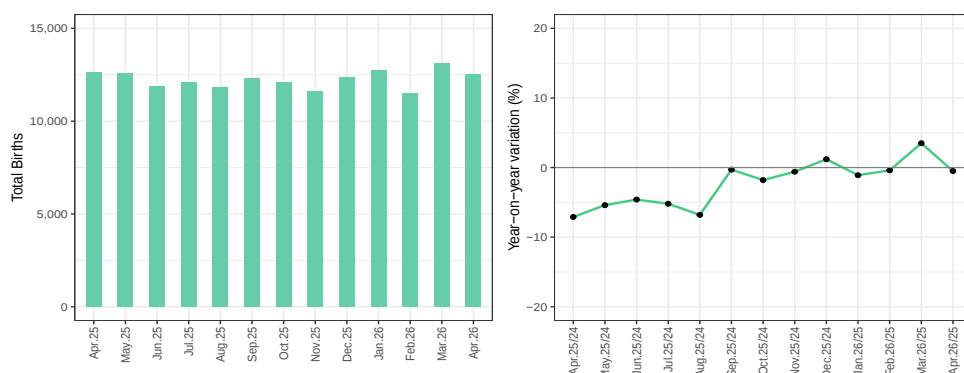
Of live births, 6,336 were male (50.5% of total records), while 6,204 were female, accounting for 49.5%. Two births of indeterminate sex (0%) were also observed.

The number of births decreased 68 year on year, which represent a fall of 0.5%. Compared with the previous month, they decreased by 581, or 4.4%.

In April, the distribution of births according to the mother's age bracket was as follows: 8 live births to mothers under age 15, which was 0.1% of the total, and 420 births to mothers aged 15 to 19 years, which account for 3.3% of births. The bracket with the greatest number of births was to mothers aged 30 to 34 years, with 3,614 live births (28.8% of the total).

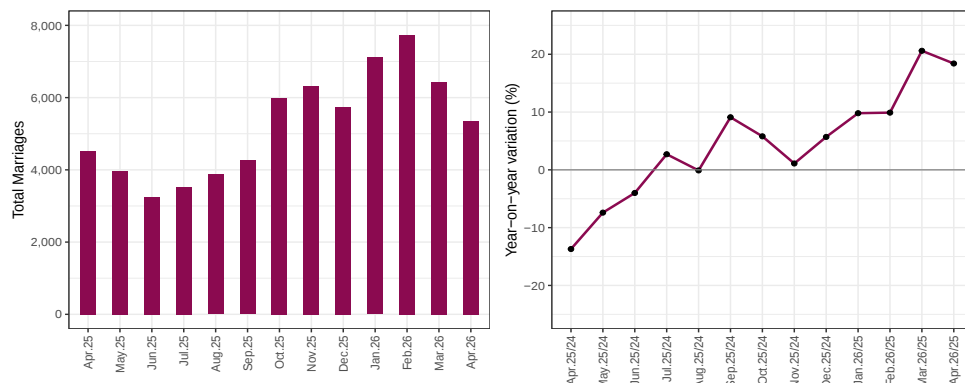
MARRIAGES AND CIVIL UNION AGREEMENTS (CUAs)

In April, there were 5,361 marriages and 2,366 Civil Union Agreements.

The number of marriages increased by 834 year on year (18.4%). Compared with the previous month, they fell by 1,080, or 16.8%.

■ Marriages according to month and their year-on-year variation (%).

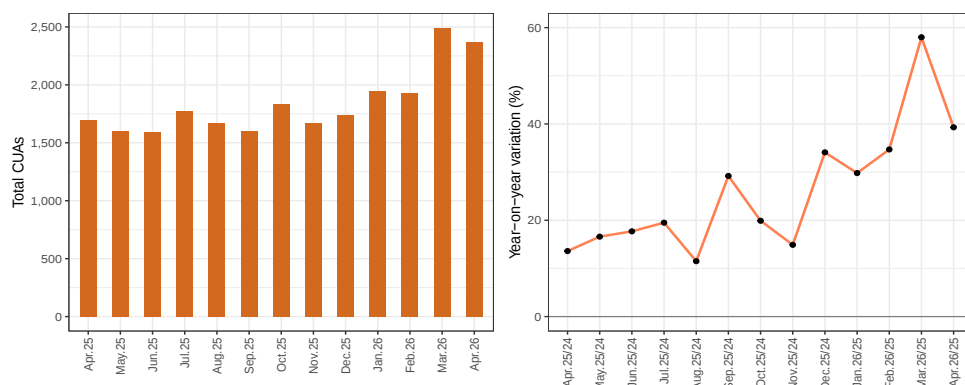

The number of CUAs rose 667 year on year, which represents an increase of 39.3%. There were 128 fewer CUAs compared to the previous month, a fall of 5.1%.

Of the 2,366 CUAs in April, 2,125 (89.8%) were of different sexes. The number of CUAs between men was 107 (4.5% of the total), while the number of CUAs between women was 134 (5.7% of the total).

DEATHS

In April 2026, there were 10,041 deaths.

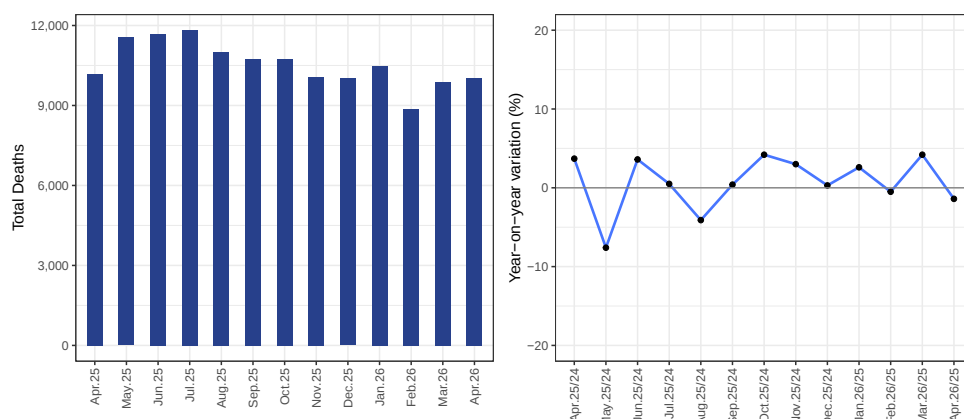
Of the total registered deaths, 5,183 were male (51.6%), while 4,858 were female (48.4%).

The number of deaths decreased by 140 year on year, a fall of 1.4%. Compared with the previous month, they increased by 145 (1.5%).

In the month under analysis, the age distribution of deaths showed 77 deaths of persons under 1 year of age (0.8% of the total), the majority of which were male. The greatest number of deaths occurred in those aged 60 and over, and the single bracket with the highest number of deaths was 80 to 99 years, in which there were 4,258, or 42.4% of the total. For those aged 0 to 79, there were more male deaths than female deaths, while the trend was reversed for those aged 80 and over, in which the majority of deaths were of females.
