

BIRTHS

In June 2026, there were 12,080 births.

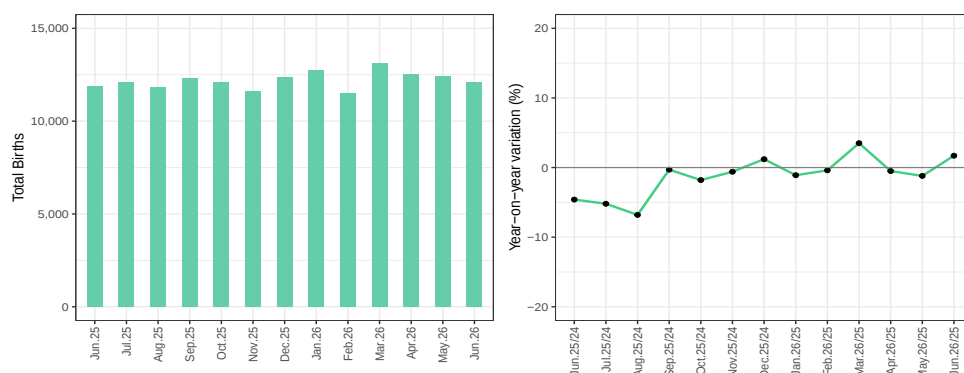
Of live births, 6,144 were male (50.9% of total records), while 5,934 were female, accounting for 49.1%. Two births of indeterminate sex (0%) was also observed.

The number of births increased 205 year on year, which represent a rise of 1.7%. Compared with the previous month, they decreased by 340, or 2.7%.

In June, the distribution of births according to the mother's age bracket was as follows: 15 live births to mothers under age 15, which was 0.1% of the total, and 398 births to mothers aged 15 to 19 years, which account for 3.3% of births. The bracket with the greatest number of births was to mothers aged 30 to 34 years, with 3,611 live births (29.9% of the total).

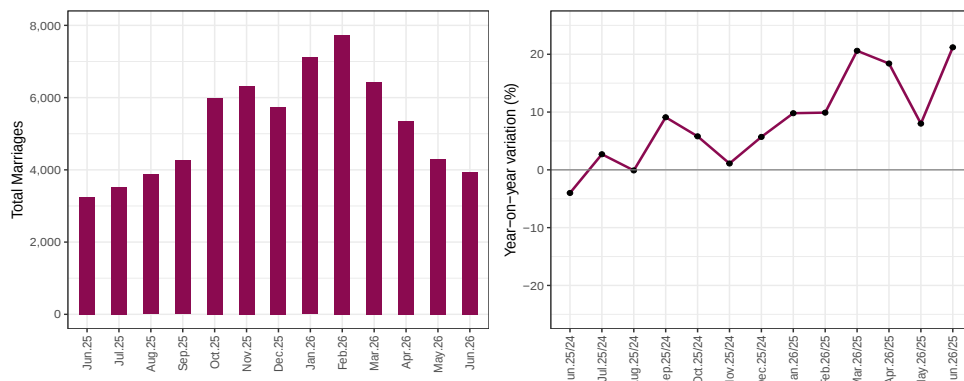
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MARRIAGES AND CIVIL UNION AGREEMENTS (CUAs)

In June, there were 3,937 marriages and 2,470 Civil Union Agreements.

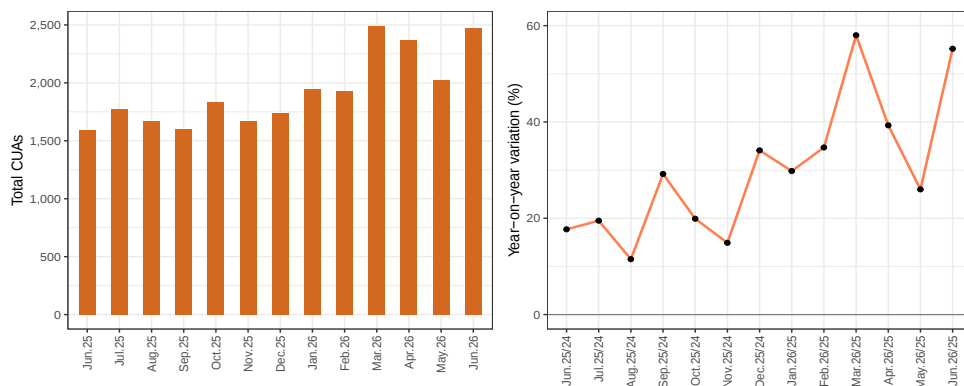
The number of marriages increased by 689 year on year (21.2%). Compared with the previous month, they fell by 355, or 8.3%.

The number of CUAs rose 879 year on year, which represents an increase of 55.2%. There were 448 more CUAs compared to the previous month, a rise of 22.2%.

Of the 2,470 CUAs in June, 2,247 (91%) were between different sexes. The number of CUAs between men was 115 (4.7% of the total), while the number of CUAs between women was 106 (4.3% of the total).

DEATHS

In June 2026, there were 11,285 deaths.

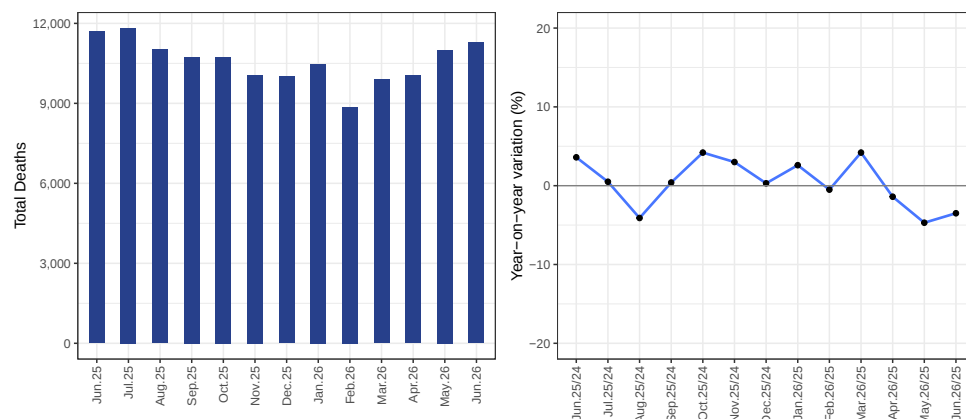
Of the total registered deaths, 5,894 were male (52.2%), while 5,391 were female (47.8%).

The number of deaths decreased by 410 year on year, a fall of 3.5%. Compared with the previous month, they increased by 276 (2.5%).

In the month under analysis, the age distribution of deaths showed 73 deaths of persons under 1 year of age (0.6% of the total), the majority of which were male. The greatest number of deaths occurred in those aged 60 and over, and the single bracket with the highest number of deaths was 80 to 99 years, in which there were 5,042, or 44.7% of the total. For those aged 0 and aged 5 to 79, there were more male deaths than female deaths, while the trend was reversed for those aged 80 and over, in which the majority of deaths were of females. Meanwhile, for those aged 1 to 4, the number of deaths among men and women was identical.
