

BIRTHS

In May 2026, there were 12,420 births.

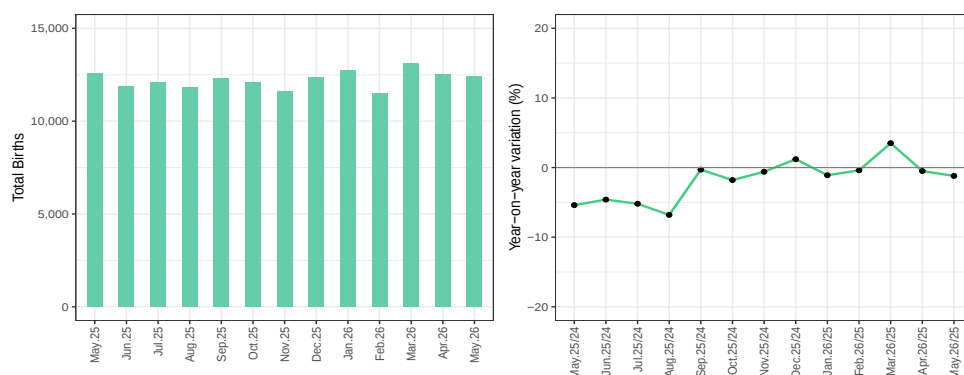
Of live births, 6,265 were male (50.4% of total records), while 6,154 were female, accounting for 49.5%. One birth of indeterminate sex (0%) was also observed.

The number of births decreased 151 year on year, which represent a fall of 1.2%. Compared with the previous month, they decreased by 122, or 1%.

In May, the distribution of births according to the mother's age bracket was as follows: 14 live births to mothers under age 15, which was 0.1% of the total, and 400 births to mothers aged 15 to 19 years, which account for 3.2% of births. The bracket with the greatest number of births was to mothers aged 30 to 34 years, with 3,554 live births (28.6% of the total).

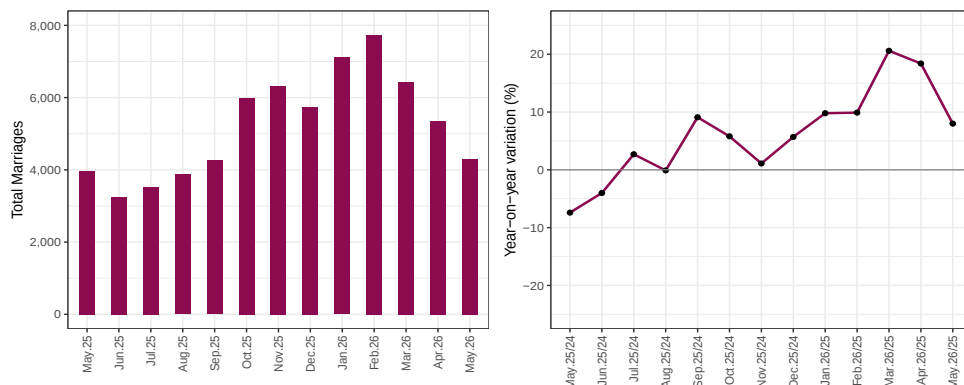
MARRIAGES AND CIVIL UNION AGREEMENTS (CUAs)

In May, there were 4,292 marriages and 2,022 Civil Union Agreements.

The number of marriages increased by 318 year on year (8%). Compared with the previous month, they fell by 1,069, or 19.9%.

■ Marriages according to month and their year-on-year variation (%).

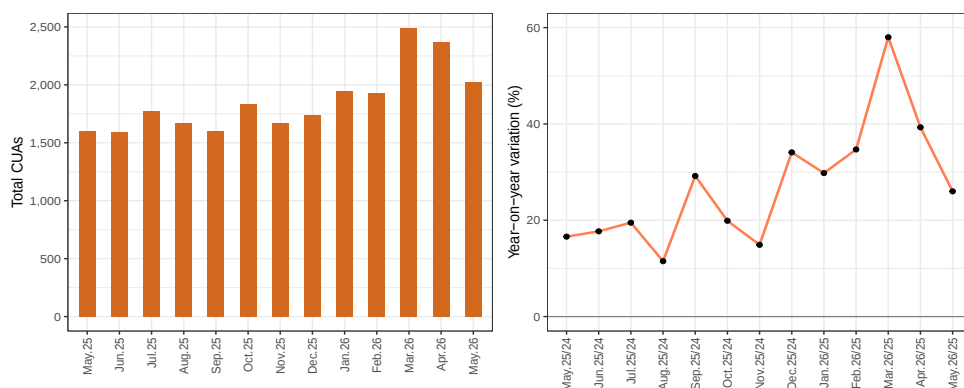

The number of CUAs rose 417 year on year, which represents an increase of 26%. There were 344 fewer CUAs compared to the previous month, a fall of 14.5%.

Of the 2,022 CUAs in May, 1,822 (90.1%) were between different sexes. The number of CUAs between men was 99 (4.9% of the total), while the number of CUAs between women was 101 (5% of the total).

DEATHS

In May 2026, there were 11,009 deaths.

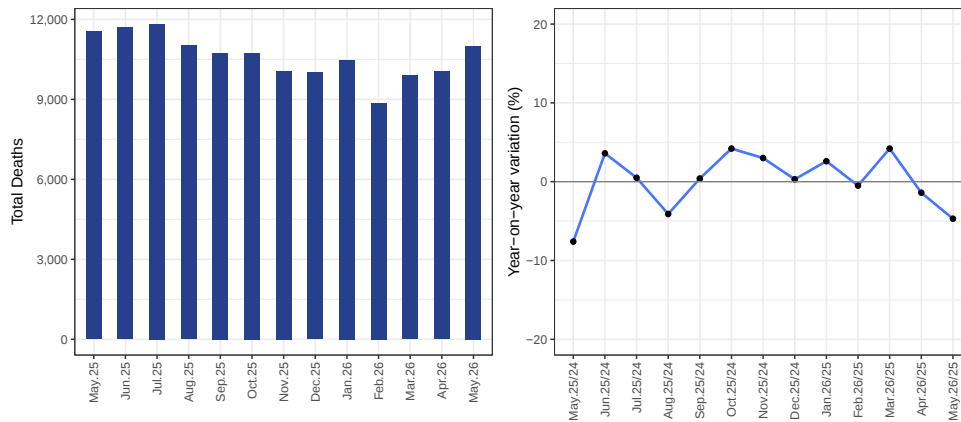
Of the total registered deaths, 5,790 were male (52.6%), while 5,218 were female (47.4%). In addition, one death of indeterminate sex (0% of the total) was observed.

The number of deaths decreased by 543 year on year, a fall of 4.7%. Compared with the previous month, they increased by 968 (9.6%).

In the month under analysis, the age distribution of deaths showed 78 deaths of persons under 1 year of age (0.7% of the total), the majority of which were male. The greatest number of deaths occurred in those aged 60 and over, and the single bracket with the highest number of deaths was 80 to 99 years, in which there were 4,770, or 43.3% of the total. For those aged 0 to 79, there were more male deaths than female deaths, while the trend was reversed for those aged 80 and over, in which the majority of deaths were of females.
